Turkey to inaugurate modernized Kapikule crossing in Balkans border

Turkish PM Erdogan is expected to formally inaugurate modernized Kapikule Border Gate on June 19.

Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan is expected to formally inaugurate modernized Kapikule Border Gate on June 19.

The Union of Chambers and Commodity Exchanges of Turkey (TOBB) concluded modernization works of the border gate with build-operate-transfer model.

Restoration works in Kapikule Border Gate started last April. The gate will be in service on 330,000 square meters area.

There is a main building including office of the general director, police department and other institutions, as well as a Free Shop, fast-food, restaurant and some other shops in the Kapikule Border Gate.
